¹ Hand and key hole saw, hammer, pocket tape, combination square, carpentry belt-overalls, T-Bevel, level, ripping bar, chalk box, plumb bob, wrench, block plane, metal box, hard hat.

² Second and third year apprentice attend 120 hours per year. ³ Second and third year apprentice attend 1 week in the winter and various Saturdays.

⁴ Tool pouch and bag, hammer, screw driver, cutter pliers, channel lock pliers, wood ruler, crescent wrench, climbing wrench, climbing boots, climbing belt w/ safety strap, pole climbers.

⁵ Claw hammer, hacksaw, metal ruler, pliers w/ crimper, diagonal cutters, channel lock pliers (2), Torpedo level w/ magnetic base, wire strippers, sheet rock saw, pocket or retractable knife, screwdrivers (Phillips & straight set), voltage tester, tool pouch/belt. Opt: Flashlight, continuity tester, long nose pliers, square & torx screwdrivers, nut drivers, allen & crescent wrenches, awl, 7/16" & 3/8" combination wrenches, gloves.

⁶ Or 18 yrs old w/ at least 4000 work hrs in line construction (provide documentation), or a Veteran w/ 2+ years (no dishonorable discharge) complete line construction and related theories (provide documentation).

⁷ Knee pads, circle cutter, plumb bob, chalk box, keyhole saw, rasp, 30' blade, end nippers, aviation snips, hack saw, utility knife, magnetic level, screwdrivers, "C" clamps, wedge clamps, good pouches, "T" square, combo square, torpedo level. These items are necessary at the time of hire: drywall hatchet, tape measure 25' or 30', felt tip marker.

⁸ The Apprentice may keep the tools upon completion of the program, if the apprentice fails to finish any used tools will have to be replaced.

⁹ Tool box, steel tape rule, bent & straight putty knife, hammer, hacksaw, nail set/center punch, hackout knife, tin snips, metal file, protractor, angle-square, laps of gloves, rubber mallet, plumb bob, socket set, awl, hand drill, 2-foot level, regular & plate & diagonal pliers, nail puller, pocket knife, glass marking pencil, razor blade holder, vinyl roller, phillips & ratchet screwdrivers, chalk line, allen wrench set.

¹⁰ Crescent wrench, 2 1/2" & 6" broad knives, 25' tape, brush/roller spinner, chalk line, duster, flat file, hammer, 1 3/4" & 1" hook scraper, nail set, pair scissors, overalls, work gloves, Phillips & regular screwdriver, pliers, pot hook, stiff & flexible putty knives, razor blade scaper, tool box, utility wire, wire brush.
