- We offer a FREE 7-week, Oregon State Apprenticeship Agency-certified, pre-apprenticeship training program, (Trades and Apprenticeship Career Class (TACC)), for self-identified women
- Our TACC class meets Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm and will be offered five times through 2018:
 - o October 3 – November 6, 2017
 - o January 9 – February 22, 2018
 - o April 10 – May 24, 2018
 - o July 10 – August 23, 2018
 - o October 2 – November 15, 2018
- The program provides career education, basic skills training, field trips to explore different trades, strength training, classroom instruction, individualized career counseling, and job placement support.

- 86% of TACC graduates are placed into high-paying, high-skilled careers with benefits!
- The average starting wage for TACC graduates is \$15.67 per hour and can go up to \$22-\$45 per hour during a 4-5 year apprenticeship
